

St. Joseph/Marquette Catholic School Acceptable Use Policy

The following are guidelines to prevent the loss of computer privileges at St. Joseph/Marquette Catholic School. Parents and students should read and discuss the below policy and then sign and return this form to the school computer instructor.

General Rules

1. Be careful not to damage the computer or the network in any way.
2. Interfering with the operation of the network by installing software is prohibited.
3. Do not view, send or display offensive messages or pictures.
4. Use limited resources such as disk space or printing capacity wisely.
5. Trespassing in another's folder, work, or files is forbidden.
6. Notify an adult immediately if you encounter materials or activity, which violates the rules of appropriate use.
7. Be prepared to be held accountable for your actions and for the loss of privileges if the rules of appropriate use are violated.

Internet Etiquette

1. The use of appropriate language is expected in all communications.
2. The release of personal information other than your name is prohibited, unless directed so by your teacher (with parent permission).
3. The sending or receiving of E-mail is prohibited.
4. The access to chat rooms is prohibited.
5. The access of information that is educational, directed by your teacher and in support of the educational objectives of St. Joseph/Marquette Catholic School is allowed.
6. The downloading of anything from the Internet without permission from the computer instructor is prohibited.

We have read and discussed the Acceptable Use Policy for St. Joseph/Marquette Catholic School and agree to abide by its policy. We understand that actions, which violate this policy, may result in a loss of privileges.
